TEN YEARS IN THE MAKING

One decade and hundreds of thousands of photographs. Practice, experimentation, and continual artistic refinement. That's what I committed before I released my first limited edition. Series in 2015. Since then, prints of the images below appear on the walls of satisfied clients from America to Australia.

In an effort to ensure the highest degree of exclusivity for my clients, I limit the number of prints of any single photograph to 9 for a given size. My goal is not only to create stunning visual art that awes and inspires viewers, but to make a collectible piece that can appreciate over time for the diligent art collector.

Each limited edition print is signed, numbered, and comes with its own certificate of authenticity, which is printed on metal and monogramed.

THE PRINT

Each print is masterfully completed on high gloss aluminum using the ChromaLuxe dye–sublimation process. Aluminum is chosen as the print medium of choice given its high degree of durability and reflectivity. ChromaLuxe has earned its reputation as "the leading brand of print media providing ultimate image clarity and vibrancy. Through dye–sublimation, images are infused into specially coated surfaces to provide the most durable, longest lasting print medium. The vibrancy and dimensionality of ChromaLuxe products rival any photographic product."

Once printed, an additional transparent protective seal is then applied to the print which makes it both waterproof and scratch resistant. This helps ensure that your art will be enjoyed for decades to come.

Large prints (60"+) can be divided and printed onto three separate aluminum panels at no extra charge.

International shipping is also available. Using a private logistics company, I've been able to deliver 100+ pound pallets with prints to clients as far away as the outback of Western Australia, and at rates far better than at publicly available parcel services.

For those seeking a highly exclusive piece of stunning nature photography, I look forward to helping you place one of my pieces on your wall.




"PHANTASM"


"SUMMER'S FLOW"


"TIME'S CORRIDOR"

Location: Zion, Utah, USA

"A unique slot canyon, named for its massive tube—like shape carved out by centuries of the North Creek in the backcountry of Zion National Park. The shifting colors of the stone, creek, and emerald pools transfix the eye and enliven one's sense of wonder."

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"Na Mokulua"

"A tranquil beach and a brilliant sky over Na Mokulua — Hawaiian for 'the two islands' — viewed from the coast of Lanikai, Oʻahu. Serenity and inner calm abound in this personal favorite image."

LOCATION: ARCHES NATIONAL PARK, UTAH, USA

"Delicate Arch — the most iconic natural arch in the world. In order to capture this natural phenomenon in a new LIGHT, I PATIENTLY WAITED FOR THE HELP OF THE COSMOS. CENTERING THE MILKY WAY AND THE GALACTIC CORE IN THE ARCH GIVES an interstellar aura. The result is a nearly surreal image that feels as if it is bending both space and time."



"MORNING GLOW"

Location: Canyonlands, Utah, USA

"A unique take on the sunrise shot of Mesa Arch in Canyonlands, this massive image emphasizes the curvature of the arch and the resplendent orange glow from the sun underneath."



"Within Horseshoe Bend"

Location: Page, Arizona, USA

Date Taken: July 2nd, 2015 Print Sizes Available: 72"x38.5", 84"x45"

"To lend a new perspective to this famous natural landmark I descended onto a stone ledge inside the canyon rim walls to capture this immense panorama. The emerald waters of the Colorado River glow below in a midday sun."

PRICING

The price of each print scales with client demand and the remaining supply. They also scale with size, though it is worth noting that the largest sizes remain the best value when measured on a per-square-inch basis.

Price includes insured shipping to Park City, UT — where most of my clients reside — as well as float mounted framing, so each piece is ready to hang out of the box.

Once a print has reached its limit of nine prints, the series is closed and "That's all folks!" No more prints will be made, and the original photographic file gets deleted. That ensures the value of the series and the integrity of the print run.
